



# Jim's Summary

January 19, 2017

1. At 1/11 meeting:

Barb Mittman gave an update about our club fixing/serving food at Food at 1<sup>st</sup> on 1/16. All ingredients will be furnished. We would need about 3 people around 3:30 to do food prep. and an additional 3-4 to cook and serve around 4:30. However because of an ice storm it was cancelled on the morning of 1/16.

Jerry Radke gave a report on his attendance at the Lions Mid-Winter Conference.

Elijah introduced Luke Feilmeier, Story County Park Ranger who was the program for the evening
2. Our next meeting on 1/25 will be for welcoming prospective members and Jerry Radke is responsible for the program.
